**2009– 2010 COST OF ATTENDANCE BUDGETS**

The budgets shown below are *estimated* amounts students may expect to pay for costs for the 2009-2010 school year. In addition to the *direct costs* of tuition/fees, books and supplies, and room and board, estimates are provided for the *indirect costs* of transportation and miscellaneous expenses.

For each student who applies for financial aid, the Office of Student Financial Aid determines an appropriate budget. Then, using information from the student's Free Application for Federal Student Aid, financial need is determined by subtracting the family's expected contribution from the budget. (The expected family contribution is determined using a national formula established by the Congress.)
